 - 219 (Consultant Design) 31 Different Primes
 - 61 of 219 are Supergroup Bridges (3 Primes)
- Calendar Year 2017 projected
 - 2017: 88 Projects - \$222 million

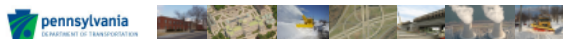

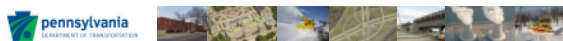


Changes in Open End Agreement Selection

23 C.F.R. PART 172—PROCUREMENT, MANAGEMENT, AND ADMINISTRATION OF ENGINEERING AND DESIGN RELATED SERVICES

§ 172.9 Contracts and administration.....if multiple consultants are to be selected and multiple on-call or IDIQ(indefinite delivery/indefinite quantity) contracts awarded through a single solicitation for specific services, specify the procedures the contracting agency will use in competing and awarding task or work orders among the selected, qualified consultants.....each specific task or work order shall be awarded to the selected, qualified consultants:(1) Through an additional qualifications-based selection procedure, which may include, but does not require, a formal RFP in accordance with § 172.5(a)(1)(ii);.....

8-0 CHANGES TO OPEN END SELECTION.....All Design Open End Agreements will be selected individually. Expect one O/E Agreement will be in the selection process at any given time during the year



Conflicts of Interest (COI)

• Observation.....

- Some firms may think a conflict of interest exists in seeking design work or working on Construction Management/ Construction Inspection (CM/CI) contracts
- These same firms may decide to not submit an SOI or may decline assignments based upon their interpretation of Publ 93
- Publ 93, Sec 1.5 (Engineering Involvement restrictions Matrix should be consulted. **Note that the matrix notes the restriction (cannot do) versus (can do)**)

• District's Expectation

- If in doubt about a COI, contact Portfolio Manager
- If District determines a conflict of interest does not exist and provides supporting documentation to this fact, it is expected that the consultant will do the work requested.
